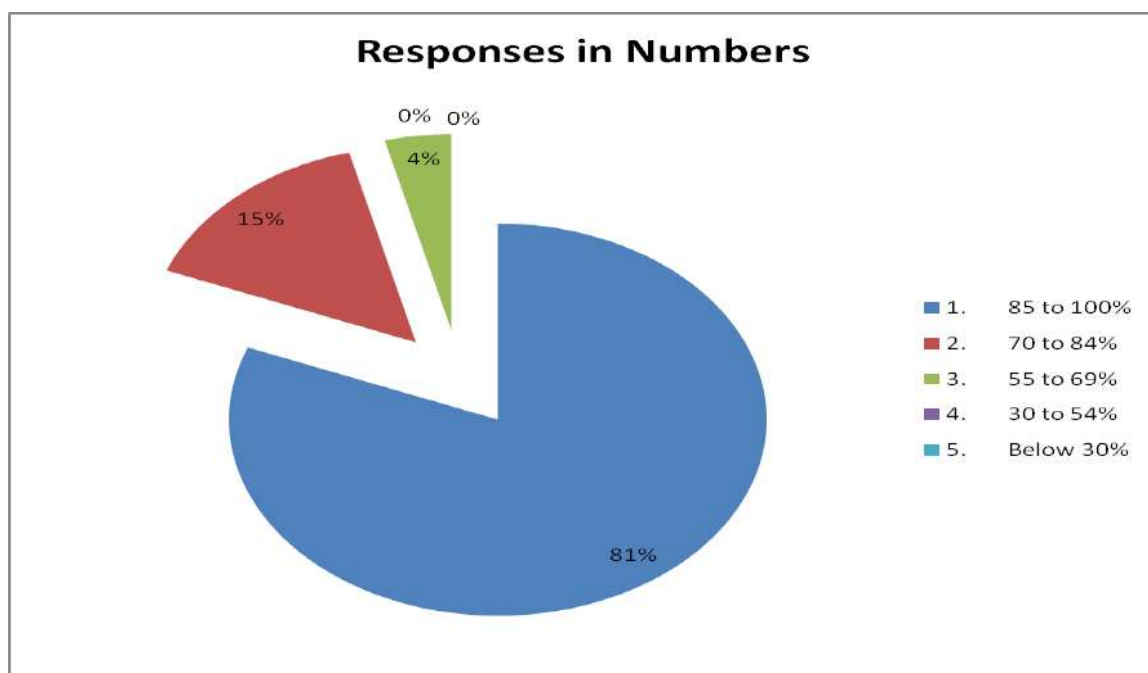


Student Satisfactory Survey Report Academic Year - 2022-23

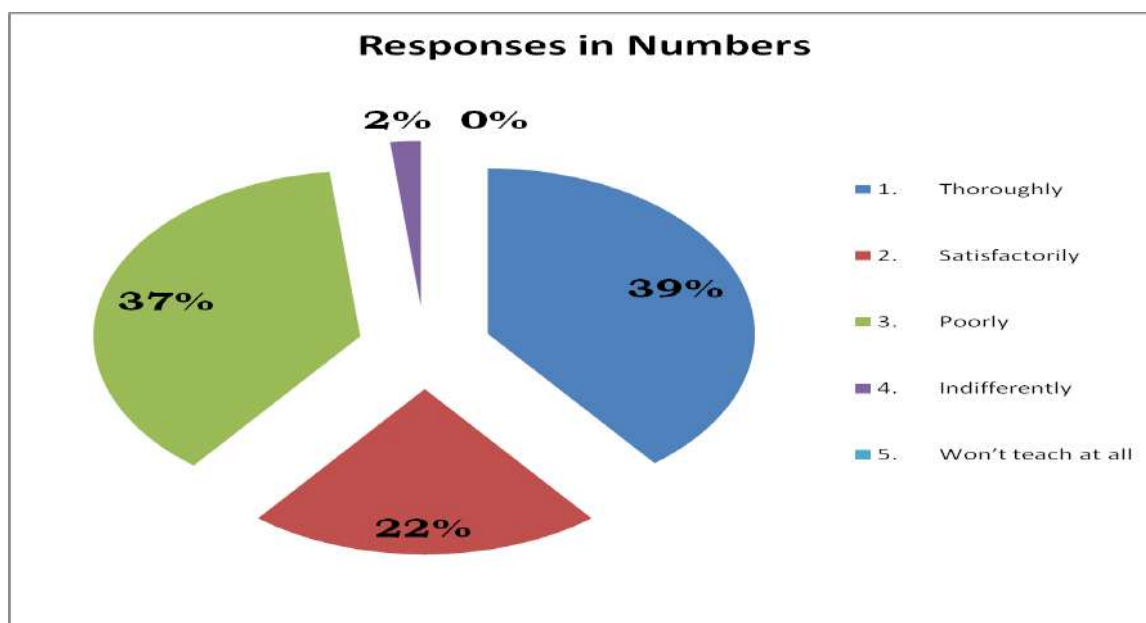
1.How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

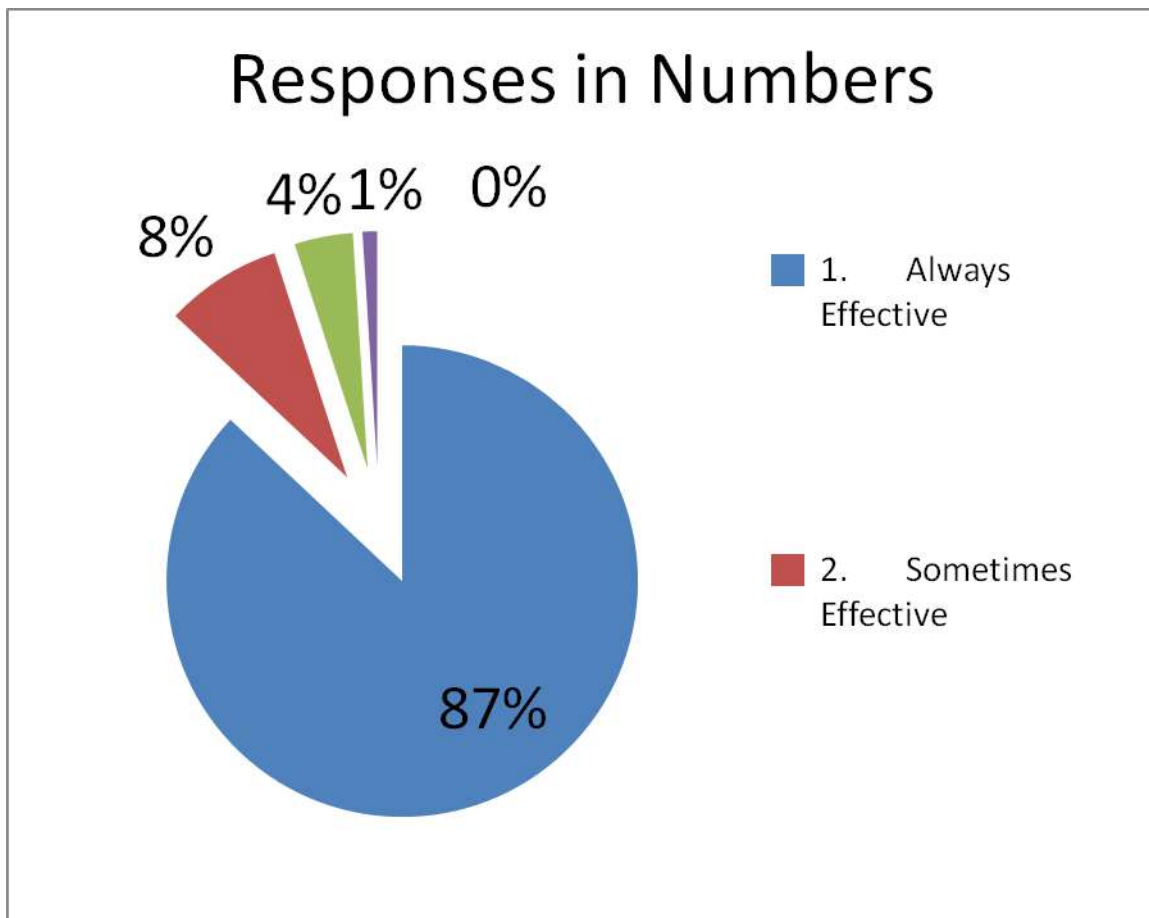

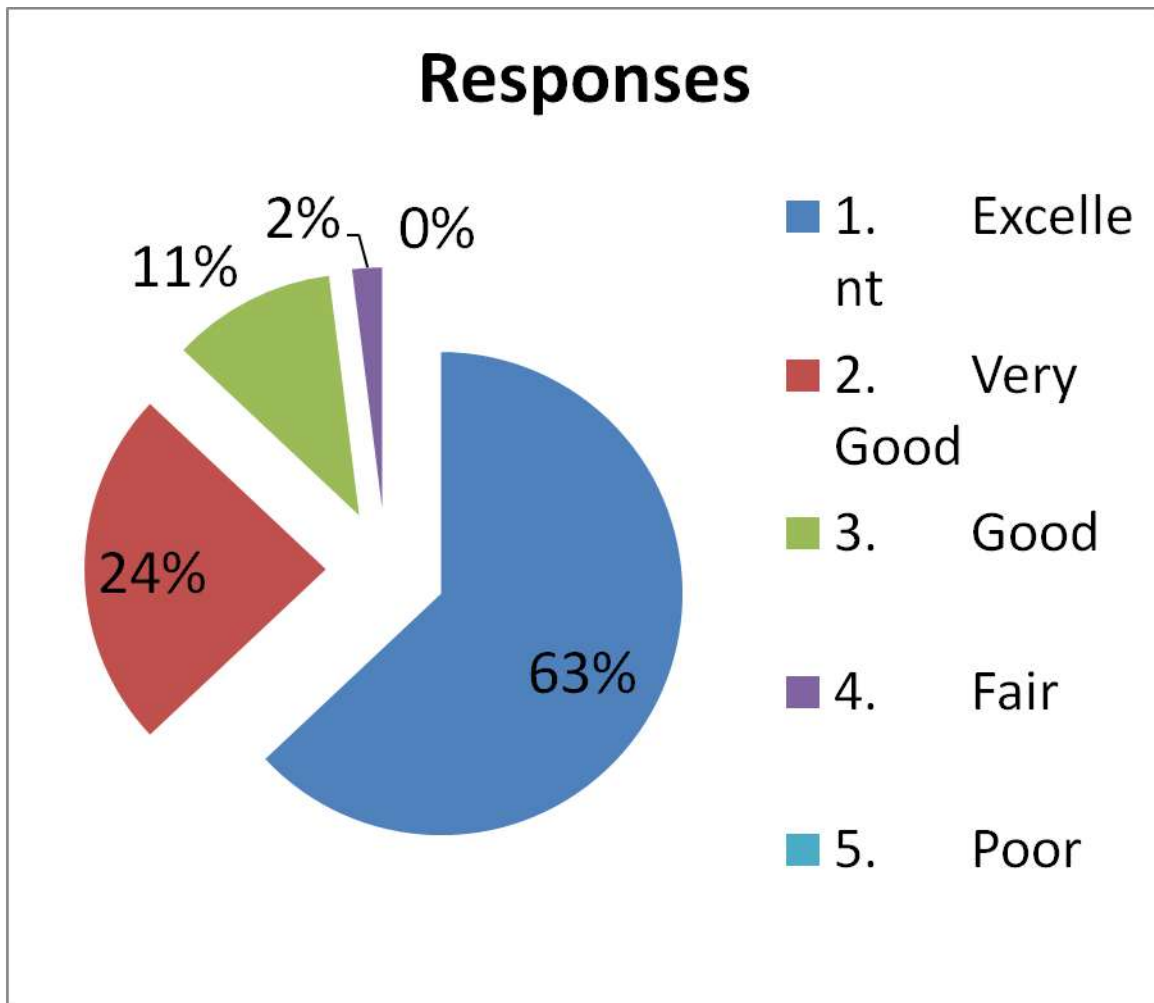

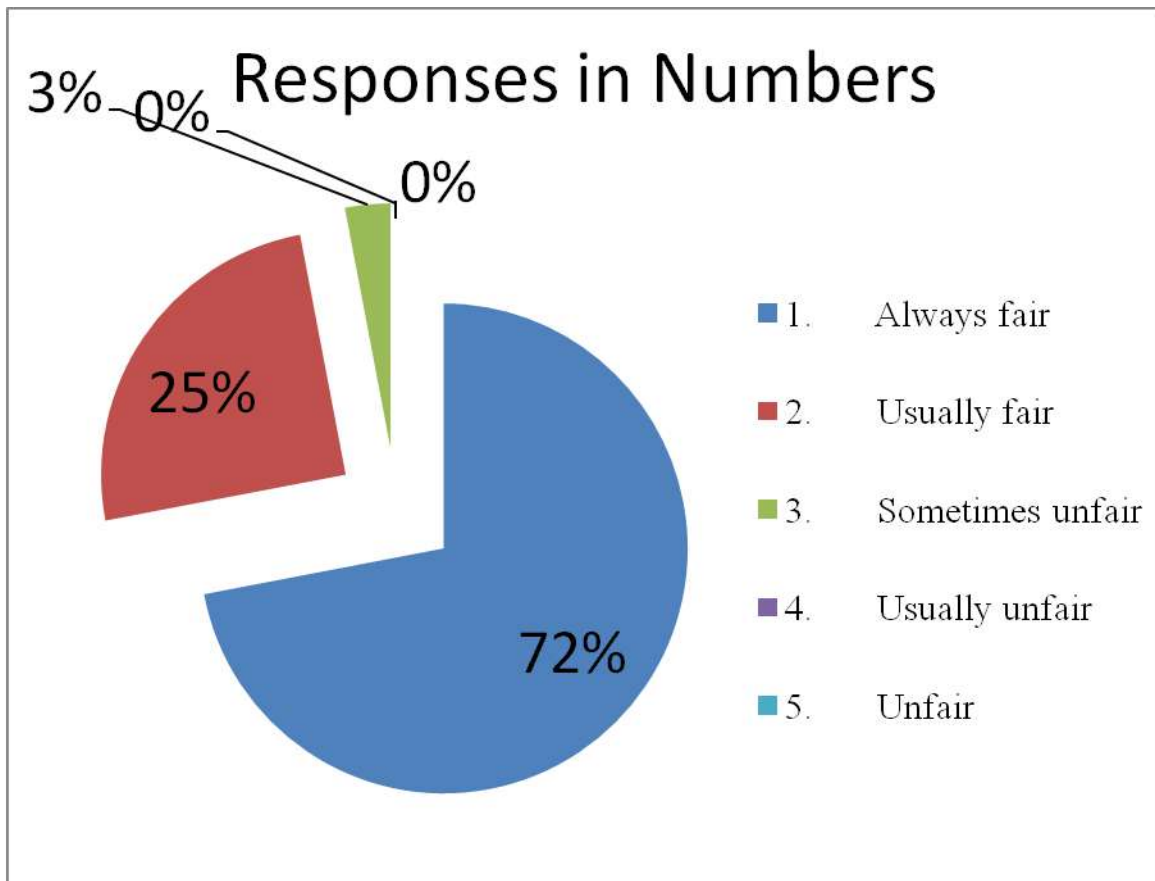

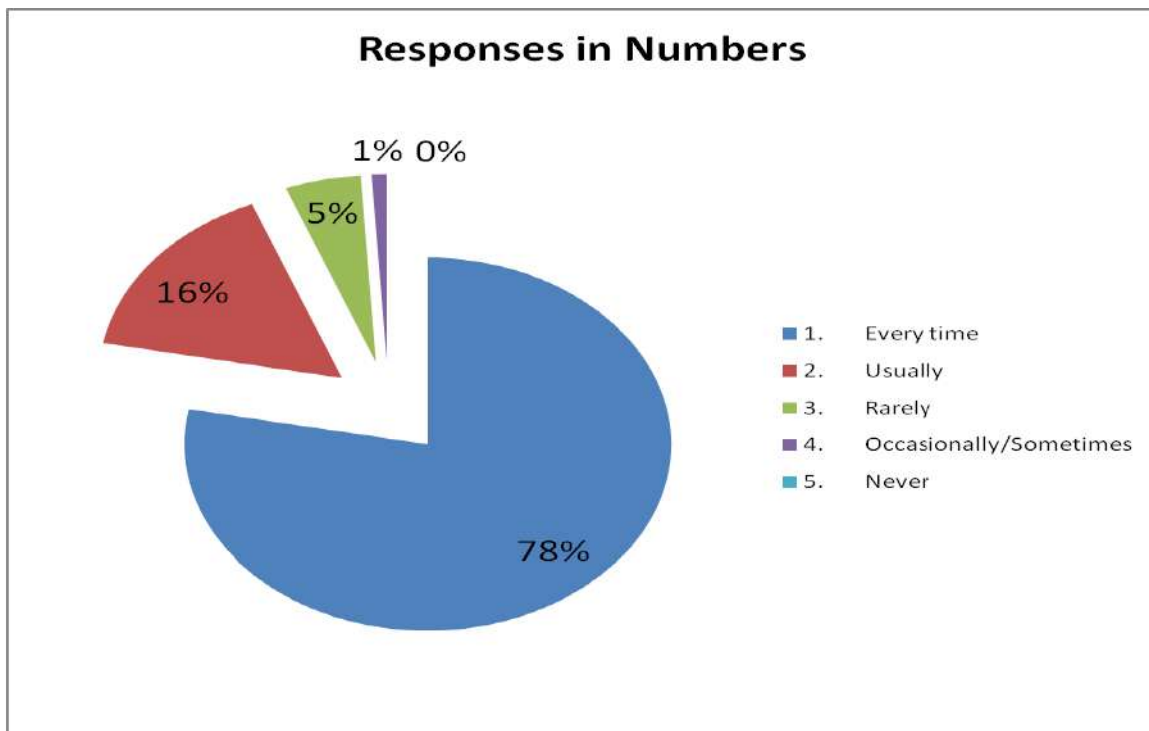

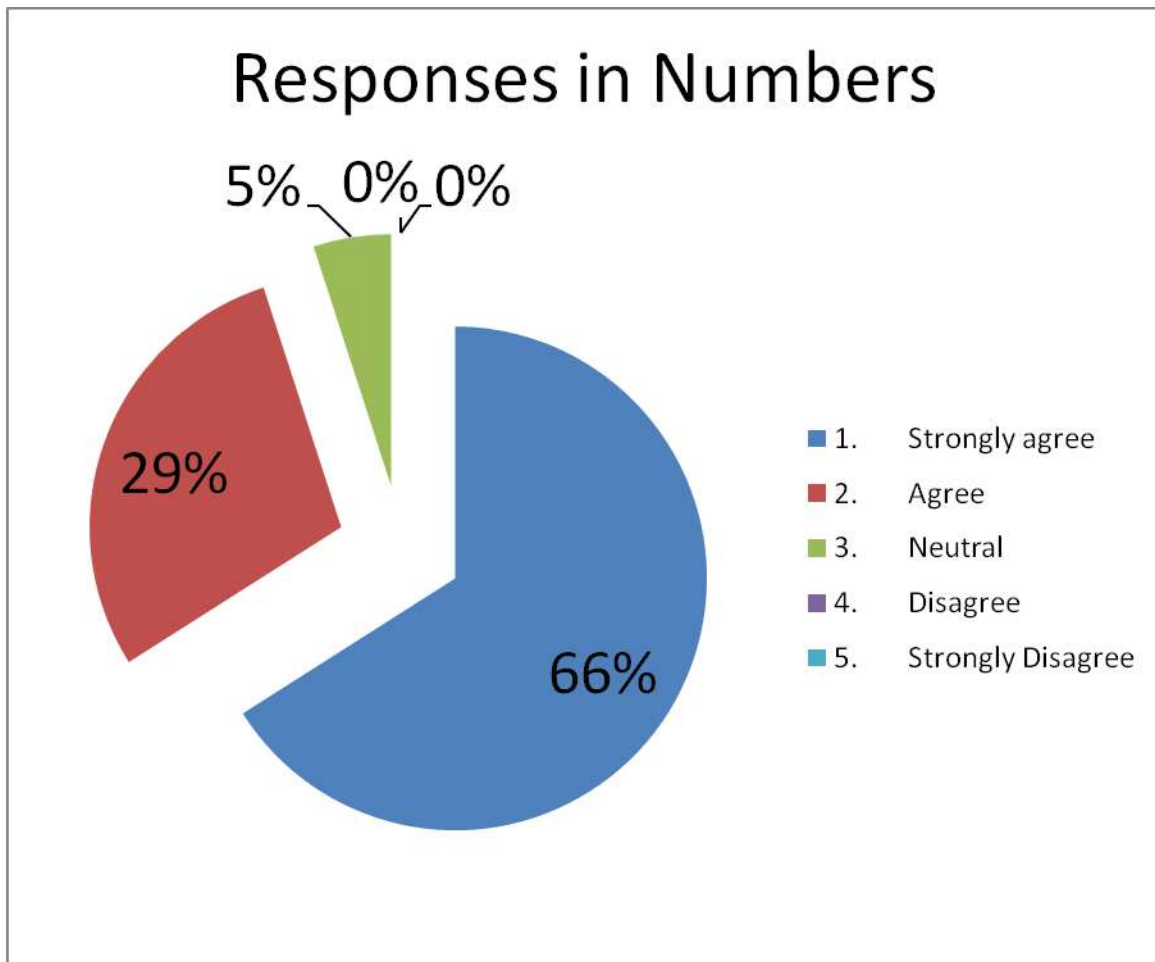

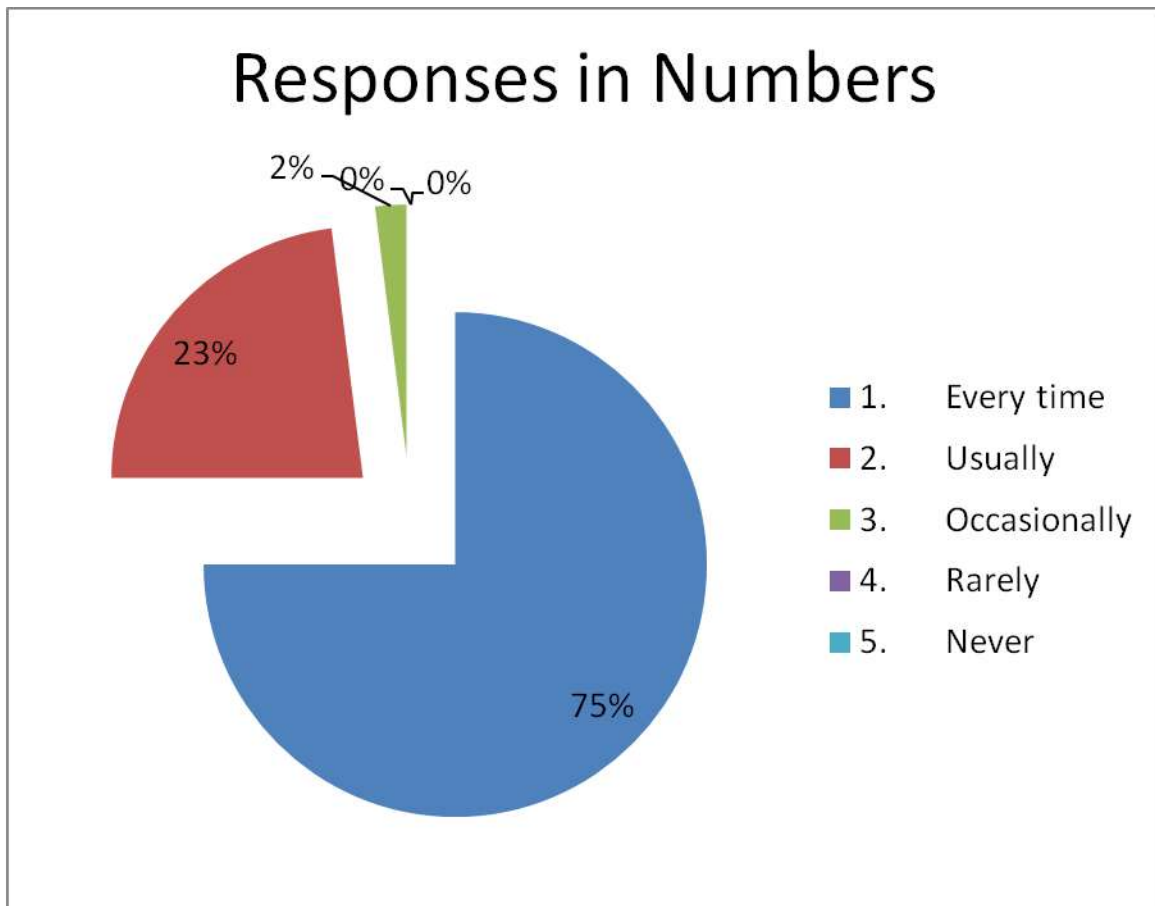

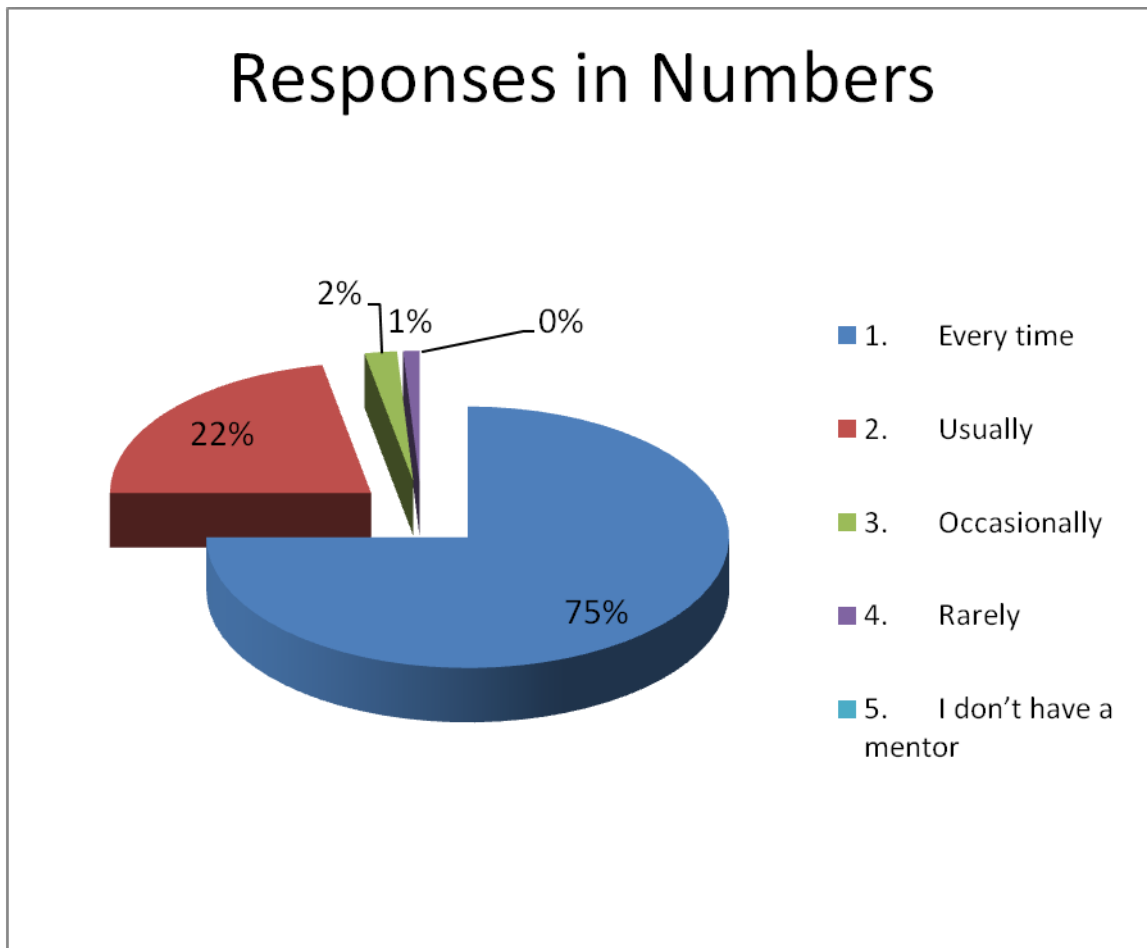

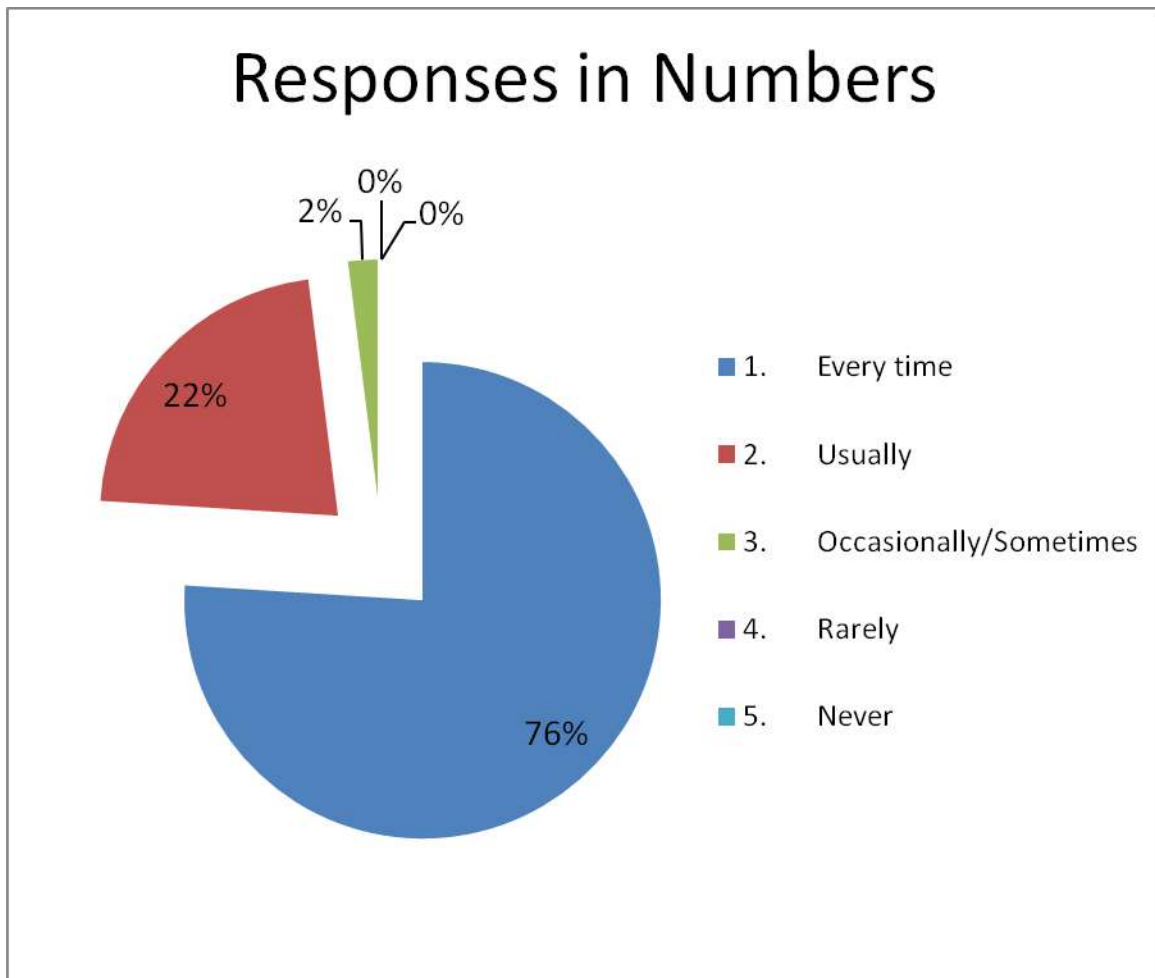

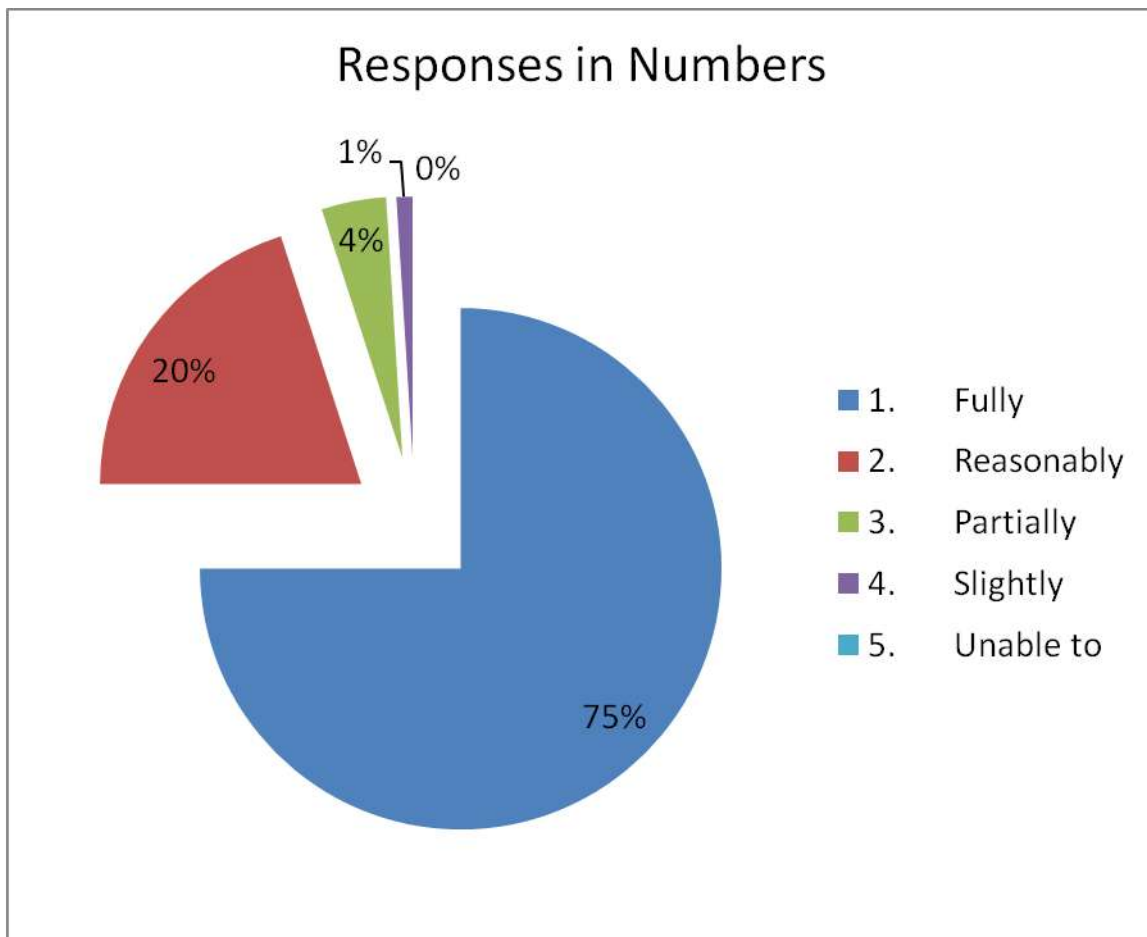

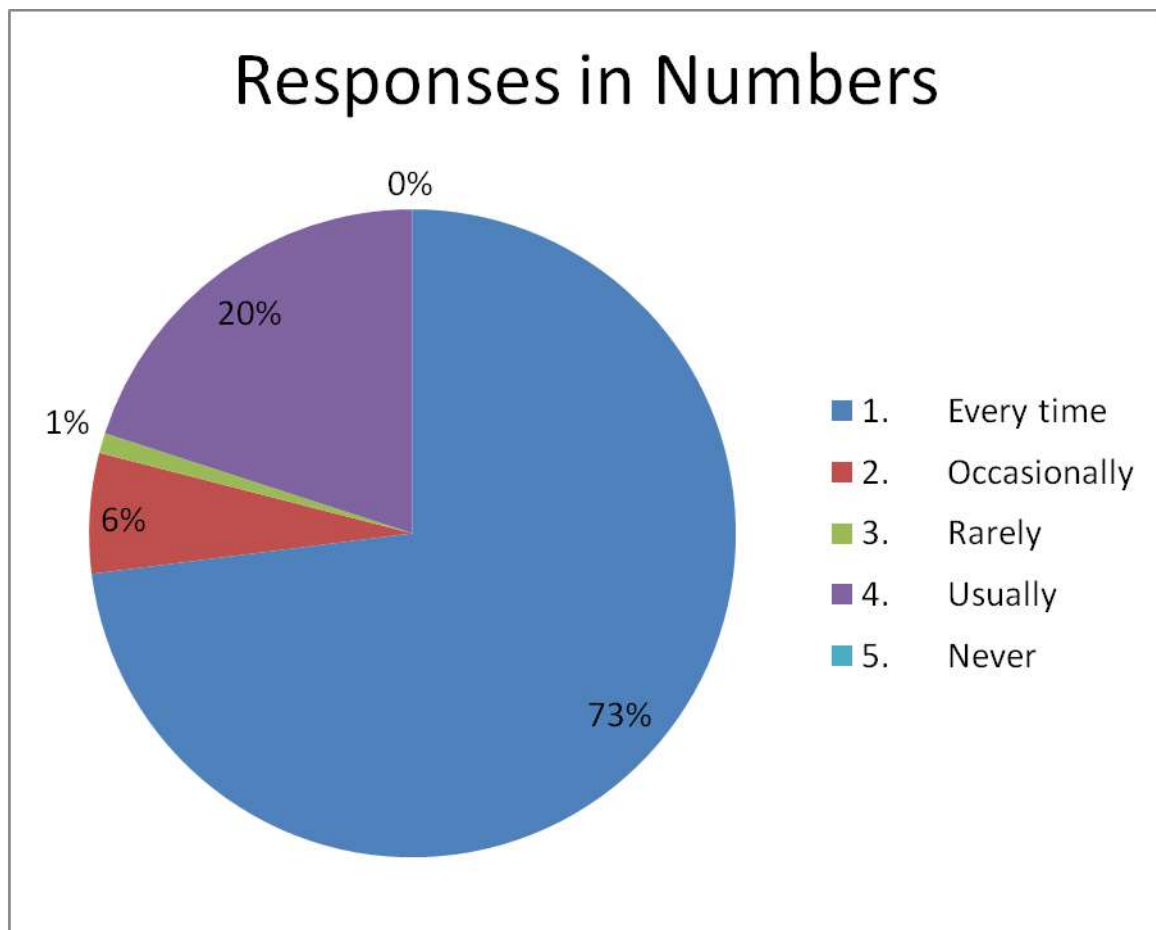

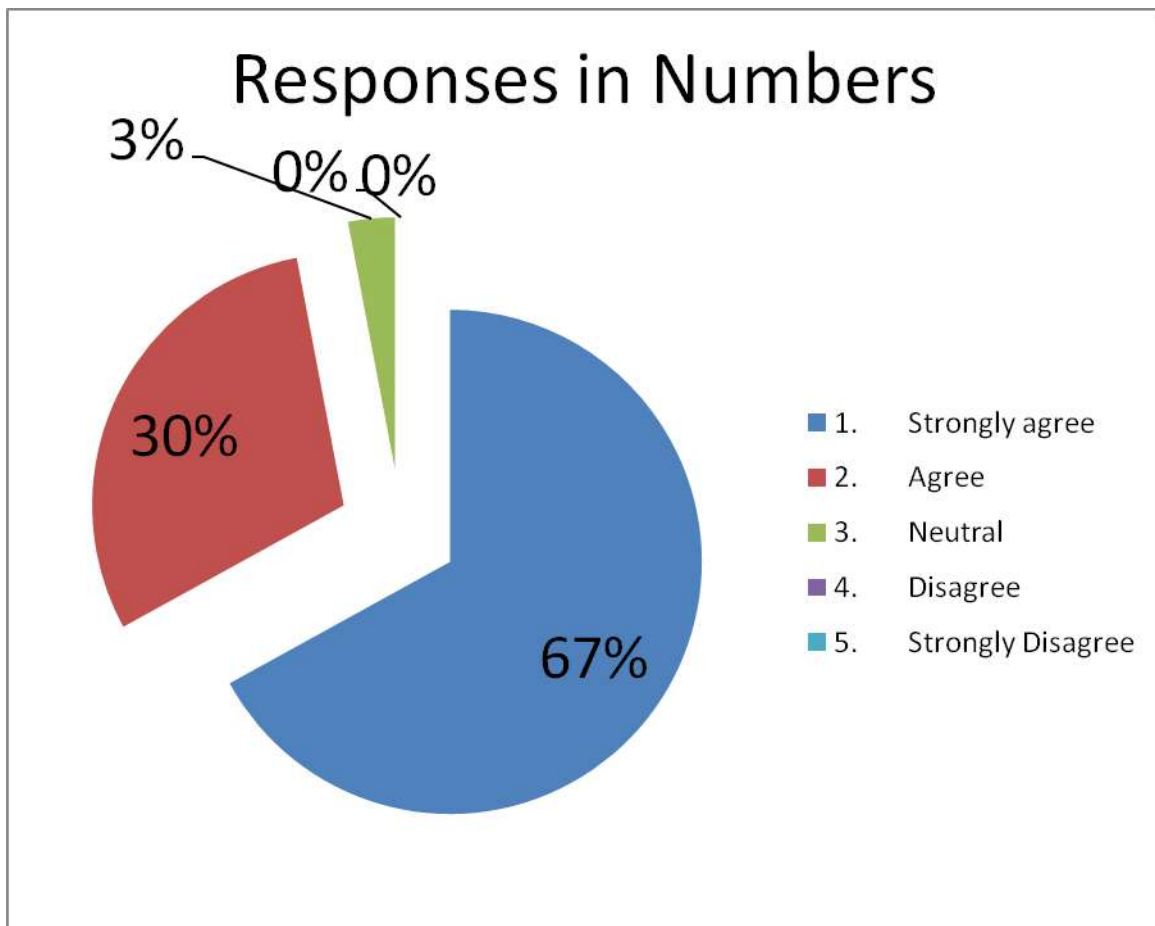

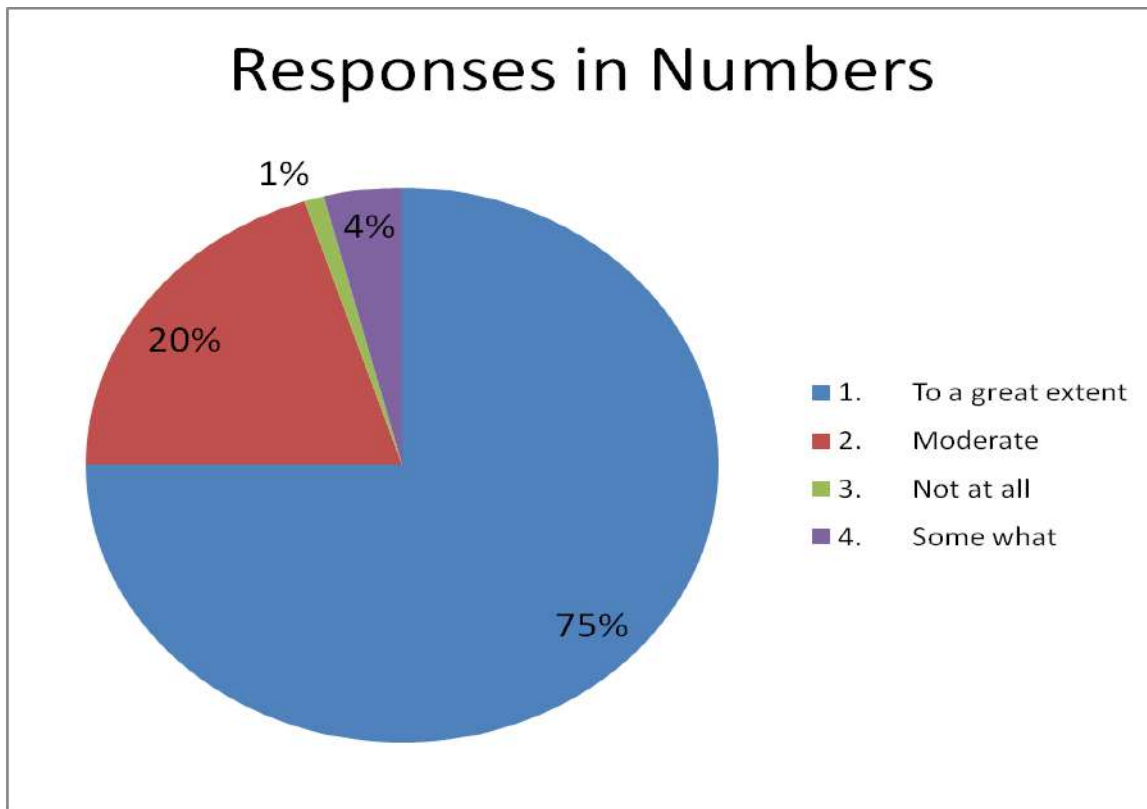

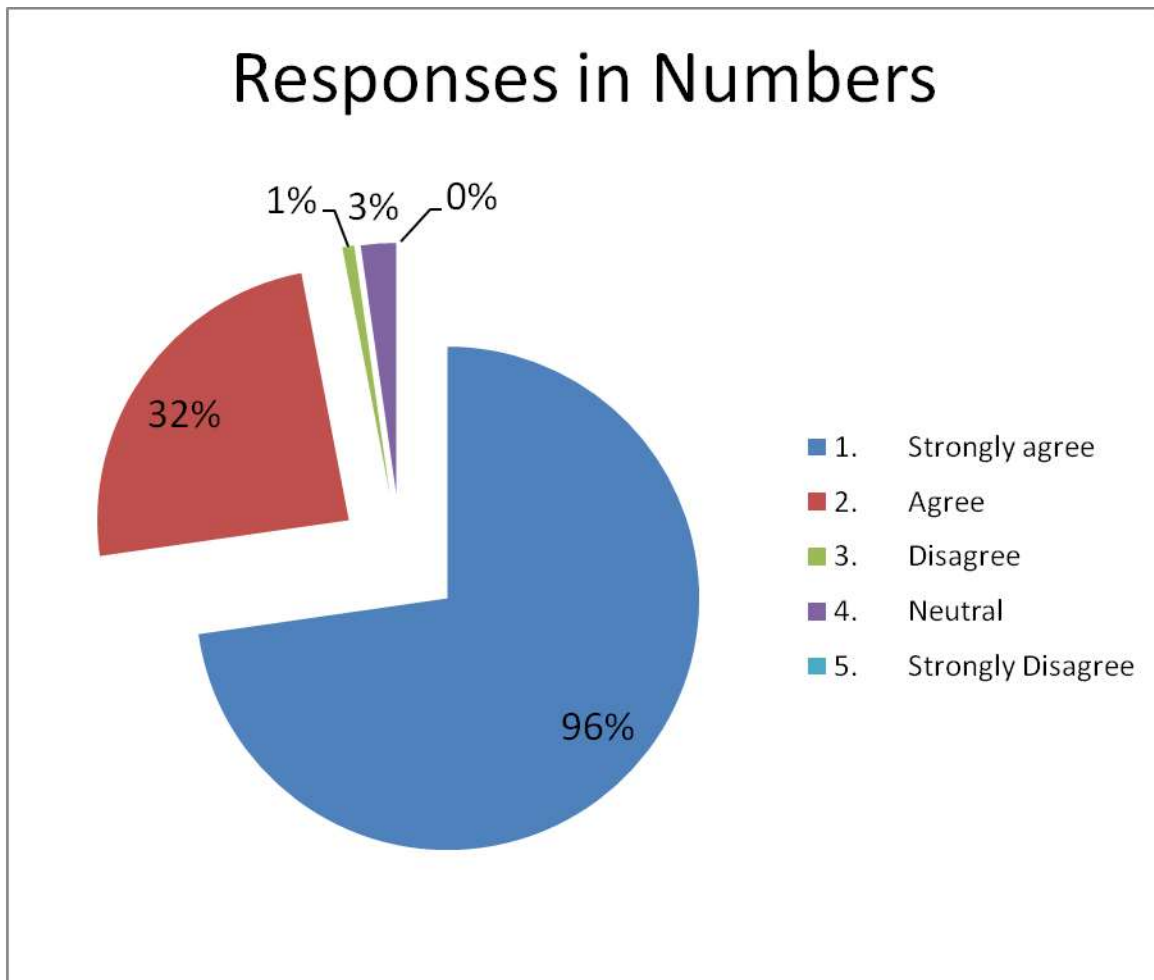

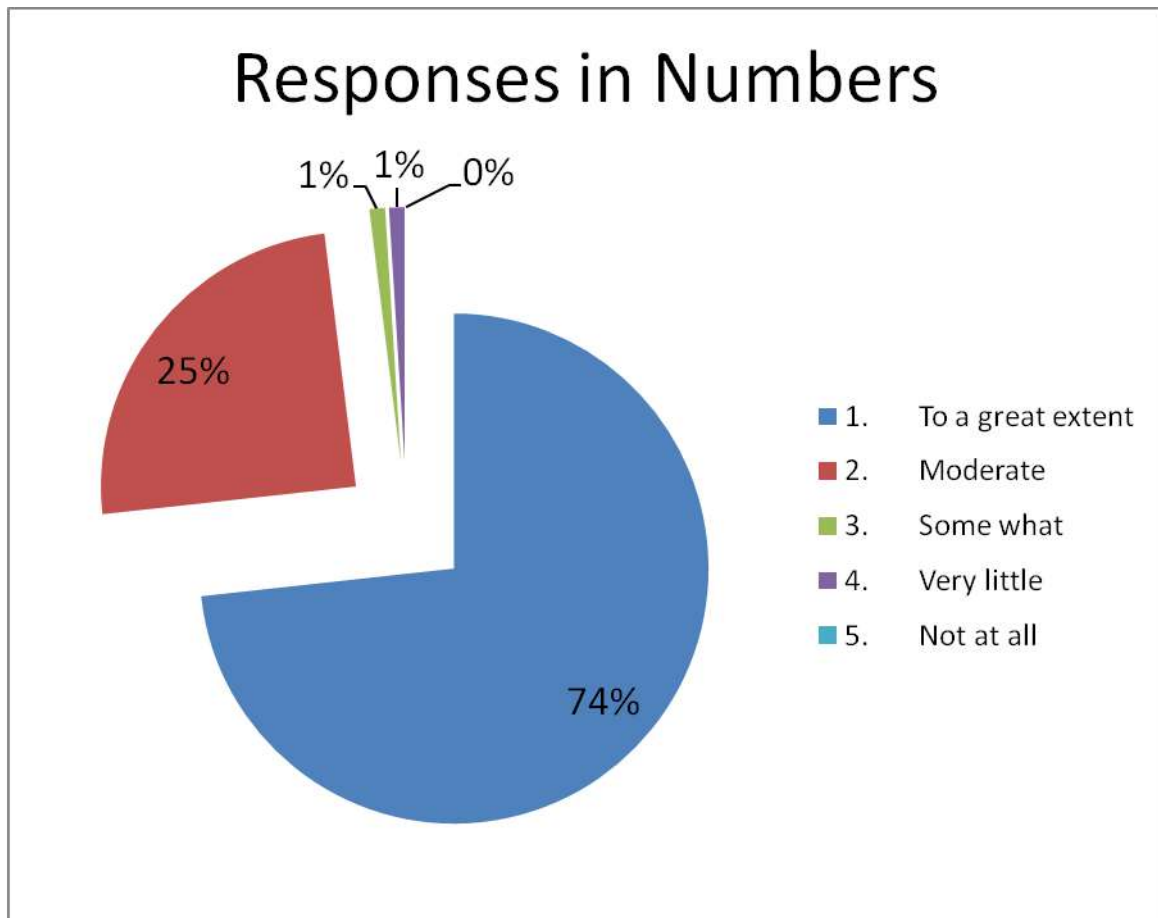

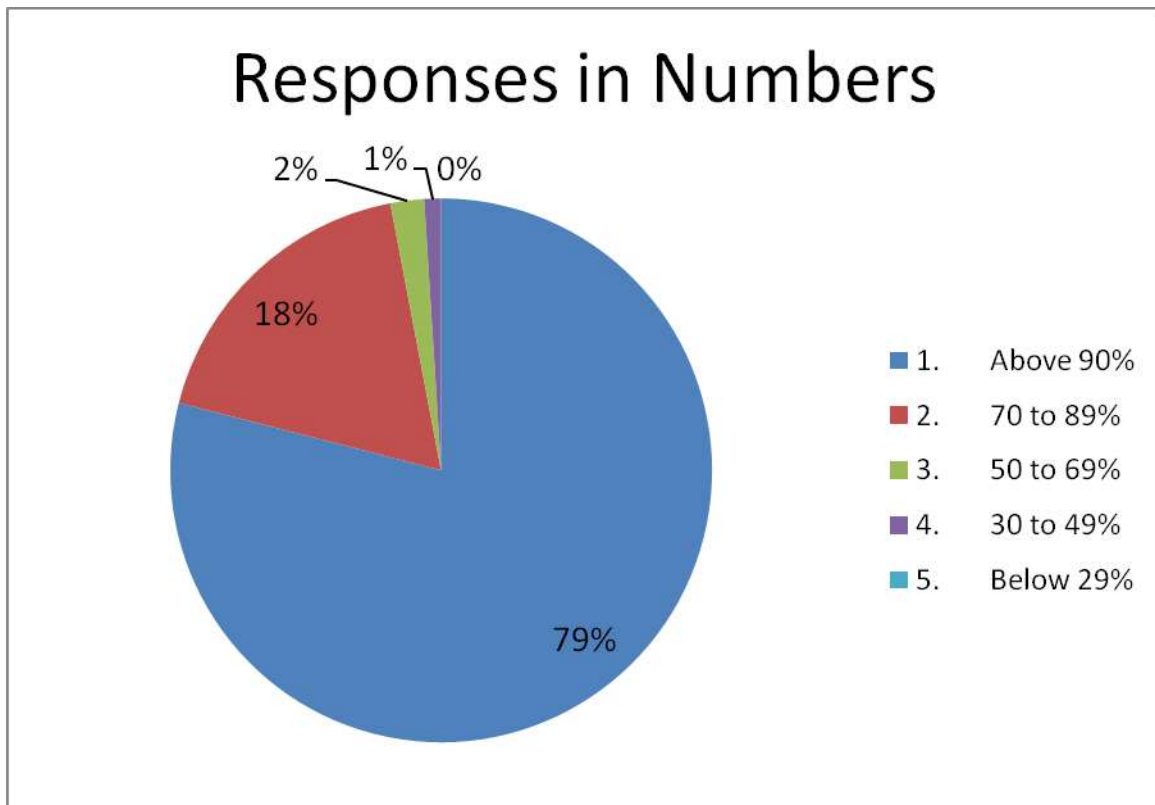

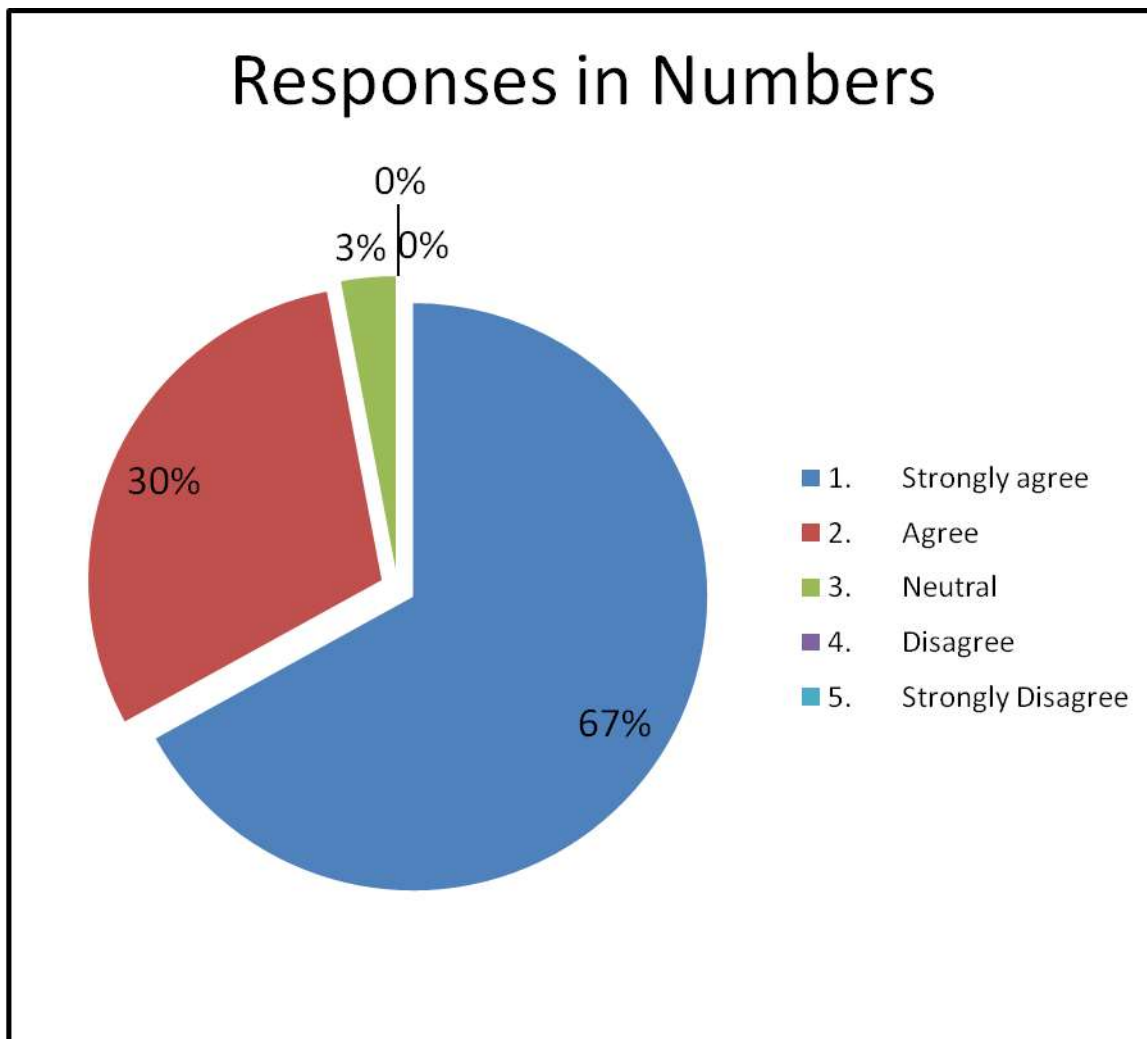
